Gina Galati founded Winter Opera St. Louis in August 2007 as the non-profit organization New Opera St. Louis. In order to better exemplify our mission we changed our name in January 2010. Our mission continues to provide the people of Greater St. Louis opera during the winter months. Furthermore, we highlight local artists and invest in the local artist community by providing an opportunity to perform with world-class talent. We are committed to enhancing public appreciation of opera in St. Louis through public participation, community education and outreach programs, and artists' workshops.

Our critically acclaimed performances continue at the recently built Kirkwood Performing Arts Center. This venue is the permanent home of Winter Opera St. Louis and we are considered the "opera company in residence" at the Center.

Aside from making opera available to St. Louis during the winter months, we have expanded our programming to reach those who might not ever have the opportunity to experience this art form. We have monthly events at various venues which cater to different interests, such as a Royal Tea, Big Band Dinner Dance, Opera and Broadway nights in the summer and Holiday events in December.

OperatoonsTM - Education and Outreach (\$5,000-\$75,000)

One of our objectives at Winter Opera St. Louis involves making opera affordable and accessible to children, youth, and their families throughout the Greater St. Louis area. To introduce opera in a fun and easy way, we are striving to create an animated opera program called Operatoons meant to be sold to schools in order to enhance their music program in an economical and feasible manner. It will also be a good option to families who home school their children. The beginning stage of this program has been developed into a Coloring & Activity Book currently available at Winter Opera St. Louis.

Operatoons will be 25-30 minute condensed animated program encompassing the story and abbreviated musical numbers of the opera. After each musical scene there will be an option to click on a musical note icon which will bring you to a different screen offering the full musical number, musical information, sing-a-long texts and fun facts.

Teachers may use their discretion on how much detail they would like to present to the students. There will be a teacher's manual included in the program, plus options to download quizzes and musical numbers for the students. This program can be used from ages 6-16.
